The Great Ames Adventure Race held Sunday at Ada Hayden Heritage Park drew 136 participants in 55 teams. Participants competed in a three-stage race - a 2.8-mile canoe or kayak race, a 15-mile bike ride, and a 3.1-mile foot race. Racers competed as solo entries or as 2-, 3-, or 4-person teams. Solo races raced each stage themselves. Teams raced as a relay. The winning team ran the course in approximately an hour and a half.
